Zambia Africa

Continue to pray for Zambia. The rainy season started well, but around the end of January, the rain just stopped. Most of the maize was about knee high at that time, and much of the country received very little to no rain for the following seven to eight weeks. The government has now declared a state of emergency and are expecting food shortages later this year. The reservoirs used for electricity are also very low, and now power cuts are already common for eight to twelve hours daily. The property we have secured is progressing well, and we hope to begin meeting there sometime around July of this year. Our main obstacle is getting a power source on the property. We are praying about whether to hook onto the grid which only works about half the time or invest in a solar system. If we go solar, the initial cost will be higher, but the monthly expenses will be reduced. We are continuing construction on the deaf school building. We recently were able to get the roof on and will soon be working on the electricity. We also will be breaking ground on the new restroom block that will be needed for the students. Please continue to pray. We are excited about what God has in store! Thank you for being a part of His work here in Zambia!
