One of our members, Bro. Moon, invited his Christian co-worker Bro. Lee to our church and he also came recently. His family sometimes attends a church in Gimhae which is over an hour away. They are looking for a closer church to go to and he decided to try our church. He has come a few times now and even went out to eat on a Friday for lunch with Michael and Mr. Moon for fellowship. Pray for him and his wife and son.

Lately, Michael has been burdened to make an online tract with audio in both Korean and English. He finished it and has posted it on our Youtube channel. We are hoping God uses that in some way to reach people. Perhaps someone can be brought to Christ through that outreach.

In closing, our children are all doing well. Alivia and Eleanor continue to study at home. Eleanor has a big middle school exam coming up in August. Please pray for her to do well and pass it. Izak continues to learn more Korean each day at public school. One of his classmates told his mother (and the mother relayed it to Freda), "Mom, Izak gets better and better at Korean every day!" That was encouraging.
