Venezuela

Dear Pastor Dove and Church Family,

Many of you were involved in the effort to get food supplies flown into some of the jungle villages where the Yanomamö were experiencing an unusual lack of available food, and I want to let you all know that the situation is now pretty much back to normal as the gardens are again producing the usual crops. What had happened this year was the lack of rain during the dry season caused the garden plants to not produce or even to wither and die. This, combined with an unusual lack of what the jungle normally produces caused a sort of "perfect storm" for there to be very little recourse for some of the villages to have enough food.

The help we provided together was enough to make a significant difference for the Yanomamö in the region where we used to live. The believers there administered the supplies among five other villages that are nearby, and it was enough to help them get through the most difficult time until the beginning of the rainy season when the gardens began to produce once again. Thank you all for your prayers and the financial support to make this happen! It was a surprise, an encouragement, and a christian example to the Yanomamö that it affected.

I sent this video once before, but wanted to put it here again. Many Yanomamö have told me to make sure I passed on their thanks! So here's a group of Yanomamö and the Venezuelan pilot, after unloading the airplane, saying thank you!
