Much of the country is now without power for up to twenty-two hours a day. Please pray for this region of the world to receive enough rain to provide some much needed relief for the people.

It was a wonderful conference, and all the leaders and workers there did a wonderful job. It is encouraging to see the people growing and taking more active roles in planning and organization.

We also praise the Lord for the several children who have recently received Christ as a result of the school and our Bible club along with a number of people in the local jail.

We praise the Lord for the projects that God has allowed us to continue or finish because of God's people sacrificially giving. We recently were able to install the solar system for the church in Makeni along with an outside shelter that can be used for children's classes. We thank God that the work on the deaf school is progressing and we are now in the final stages of construction and plan to be using it for the new school year in January. We thank God that at the end of September we were able to have our first church service on our new property for Makeni Bible Baptist Church. We can certainly say that we have found it true that our "Father knoweth what things ye have need of, before ye ask him."
