Dear Pastor Dove and Church Family,

A few months ago I asked for prayer for Mequias, as he had been sick for months and asked me to ask you all to pray for him as he really felt badly laying in his hammock sick while everyone else was going on missionary trips.

Well, the praise part is, Mequias left yesterday leading a team up the Orinoco to another river called the Manaviche River to a village up there called Calojiteli. The last time I was up there was when I was 15 years old. I don't think any missionary has been back in that village since I was there, and no one has been back in this village with the Gospel since that time. I honestly had forgotten all about this village until I located it on my sat map. While showing the sat map in one of our planning sessions, I talked about the last time I had been in that village. I had actually gone there with Bautista, Mequias' father who was over in the Mavaca area working with Dad and Mom at the time. When Mequias heard this, he informed us he wanted to go and take the Gospel there. When I asked him if he felt up to a long river trip he grinned and said, "I am healed. it is time I get back to work. Besides, we have a new motor now and this is the first real missionary trip this motor is going on, so yes, I really want to go."

Well, our team left excited yesterday taking a projector with the movies, God's Story, all translated into Yanomamö. They also took Torches, the small solar powered audio devices to place up there. Pray for ready hearts to hear and accept the Good News.
