Dear Friends, Prayer Partners, and Faithful Supporters,

Praise God we met our goal of 5k in five days in 2023 and 2024! Our new goal for 2025 is five provinces. We are now trying to have Bible Clubs spread across five provinces this year. Praise God, we officially launched the new Bible Club organization called Christian Citizenship Inc. with its own local board. God blessed us with six godly and highly skilled local men to lead the ministry.

- Training: God has allowed us to train around 500 Pastors and Christians as Bible club leaders and teachers. We have also been able to share the gospel with about 300 public school teachers through evangelist teacher in-services.
• Funding: Praise God, \$200,000 was raised for the Bible Clubs' 2025 budget. Thank you from the bottom of our hearts.
• Curriculum: The 5,000 sets of curriculum we received was 4th to 12th-grade and we are using that for training and teaching in the Bible clubs. Please pray as we are researching a commercial printer, possibly a Riso GL9730, to print the first test runs of the K-3rd grade curriculum, training materials, and devotional journals for the Bible clubs.

We have been so encouraged by the growth in the youth of Sagifa Bible Baptist Church reading their Bibles and growing in their prayer life. Please pray Tim can finish his doctorate this year. He is getting close, but it depends partly on what his professors decided. Thank you so much for your earnest prayers.
