Dear Friends, Prayer Partners, and Faithful Supporters,

Thank you so much for your prayer support. These last few months, especially these last few weeks, have been very stressful, sad to say. But in spite of the constant attacks from the enemy, God continues to grant us small glimpses of what HE is doing in the lives of believers here.

About a week ago, we were asked by a friend to come up to his village as his wife, on her death bed, wanted to say goodbye. I grew up with this lady and she and her husband are very dear friends. So we went up there. I am not sure what I expected, I thought we would pray with her and try and encourage her, which we did, but I walked away from there being the one most encouraged. Margarita's faith and joy in the Lord was unwavering, although obviously fragile, she was radiant in her joy of the Lord and her eagerness to get to heaven and meet her Savior face to face.

Before we left, she asked if we could come back and record her testimony. We went back up there yesterday and what a blessing! She started out, her voice so fragile I was afraid we would not get a good recording of her, but as she talked, although there were long stretches where she had to pause to catch her breath, her voice strengthened and her joy and faith in her Lord shone forth. What a blessing it was to me and my nephew, Andrew who was with me with his family.

As I mentioned at the first, these days have been full of tension and much stress, the illegal activity along our rivers is now right on our main river near our village and the village is very upset. At this point, we are not sure what is going to happen. Pray God would give the leaders of the village much wisdom.
